Enough for now. There is no meeting in September. Come to the rally. See you there.



Mike Cohen gave the Treasurer's Report. All is good. Doug Twing motioned to approve Mike's report, Todd Korb seconded.

The club had received some correspondence regarding Karen Williams hip replacement, The Sunshine committee sent Karen a fruit basket.

The President, the Vice President, and the Secretary had nothing to say.

The MOA Report from Brian – The rally in 2023 will be in Richmond Virginia. It will be 1 week earlier. The number of MOA members is decreasing. Pre-register for the rally and save money.

Randy Boris came to the meeting regarding the RA. They decided to forgo asking the Wis. Club to work with them on the RA rally. They decided it wasn't going to work out for a variety of reasons and attitudes. The RA Rally will be two weeks later (September 29 – October 2) In Waynesville, NC.

AMA - we don't have an ambassador.

WIS BMW Club Rally – We need volunteers. We also need door prizes. When checking out at a vendor, just ask. You may want to inform the potential donor that Camp Wawbeek is an Easter Seals Camp. Road, Track, and Trail has donated a helmet. Door Prizes, Food, Beer, Poker Run, Field Events - the Rally is all coming together.

Doug Twing talked about leading new club rides. How about the Grumpy Troll in October? Don's Café? It's okay if it's raining. Riding in fall is fun. Set up a ride – get it posted!

The club also discussed having a "Cell Phone Sign-up" for impromptu rides. Then if a member goes on a ride, they can send a message stating the details. The club voted on this and it was approved.

Members comments:

Ride to Kenosha – Stop the Bleed – this class starts at 6 PM. Ride should start at 4:30 – 6 PM on Wednesday.

New Motorcycle – 1250 GS – This attendee brought copies of necessary torque only to find out they are the same as the older motorcycles. Maybe we need a tech day.

John was at the rally and lost his jacket on the freeway. An MOA member found this jacket and found a rally card in the pocket. As Brian's number was listed on the rally card, Brian was called.
